# **EXIT SIGN INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

# **Frame Components and Initial Construction**



### **Components:**

- 2 Short frame sections
- 2 Long frame sections
- 4 Corn



4 - Set Screws

- 4 Spacers
- 1-3/32" Allen wrench



**1.** Insert the 4 corner keys into short frame section's ends.



**2.** Using the Allen wrench, hand-tighten the set screws to secure the 4 corner keys.



**3.** Position the long frame sections with screw hole counter sinks facing up.



**4.** Slide the long frame sections onto the corner keys of the short frame sections using firm pressure. Hand tighten the set screws as shown.

## Flag and Ceiling Mounting



1. Remove the top and bottom set screws from one end of each long frame section. Pull the short frame section away from frame assembly.



**2.** Slide the EXIT sign into the first groove of the frame. For double sided exit signs, slide each exit sign into its own groove with exit lettering facing outward.



**3**. Reinstall the short frame section into the frame assembly. Align the EXIT sign(s) into the frame section groove(s). Hand tighten the set screws.



**4.** Using the mounting bracket as a template mark the position of the mounting screws on the ceiling or wall.



**5.** Secure the mounting bracket using proper hardware and techniques



**6.** Safely snap fit the framed EXIT sign into the secured mounting bracket.

# **Surface Mounting**



**1.** Using the assembled frame as a template, position the frame and mark the 4 attachment locations. Install proper anchoring hardware as necessary.



2. Position the frame with the counter sunk hole surfaces facing you. Place screw spacers between the wall and the frame while Inserting the mounting screws. Hand tighten the screws into the wall or proper anchor if used.



**3**. Loosen the top and bottom set screws from one end of each long frame section. Pull the short frame section away from frame assembly.



**4.** Slide the EXIT sign into the assembly. Reinstall the short frame section into the frame assembly. Align the EXIT sign into the frame section groove. Hand tighten the set screws.



**5**. Apply directional arrows by removing the protective plastic layer. For left exit paths apply arrow on the left. For right exit paths apply arrow on the right. If exit path is straight no arrows are needed. If exit paths are located on both left and right apply both arrows.





# GENERAL INSTALLATION GUIDELINES FOR PHOTOLUMINESCENT EXIT SIGNS

#### **UNFRAMED SIGN INSTALLATION:**

All unframed signs will be provided with pre-drilled mounting holes.

- 1. Verify that the desired mounting location has the required 5FC of light as required by code.
- 2. Mark mounting holes on the wall where the exit sign is to be mounted. Drill out mounting holes.
- 3. Use appropriate anchoring as required by the wall materials being used and local governing building codes.
- 4. Remove any plastic protective film from the back and front of sign before mounting.
- 5. Mount the exit sign and screw into place.

CAUTION: When mounting signs from the ceiling and walls, please use cautionary measures to ensure that signs are mounted high enough to avoid creating head hazards for tall occupants.
