INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FLAG/CEILING MOUNT

PARTS INCLUDED:

☐ EXIT SIGN

☐ Part - Z (metal bracket: 4 circular holes)


Notes:

First determine location for the flag/ceiling-mounted exit sign. Installer should use appropriate fasteners depending on type of surface material.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Position Part Z on wall or ceiling and mark holes.
- 2. Drill the four holes using a ¼" drill bit.
- 3. Install anchors (not included) in drilled holes. ***
- 4. Install appropriate fasteners.
- 5. Snap Exit Sign into place.
- 6. Once in place, Exit Sign can slide (ceiling-mount only)

WALL MOUNT


PARTS INCLUDED:

- ☐ EXIT SIGN
- □ Part A (metal bracket: 2 circular holes)
- ☐ Part B (metal bracket: 2 rectangular holes)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Determine location for the wall mounted sign.
- 2. Position Part A on wall with groove side down and level.
- 3. Install Part A ½ inch below the top of the sign frame.
- 4. Drill two holes using a ¼" drill bit.
- 5. Install two anchors (not included) in drilled holes. ***
- 6. Use suitable fasteners (not included) through Part A and screw into place. **
- 7. Using a level, measure 5-1/4" below Part A to position Part B.
- 8. Position Part B with groove side down.
- 9. Drill holes and install anchors.
- 10. Part B's rectangular slotted holes allow for adjustment.
- 11. Hang top of exit sign on Part A.
- 12. Push bottom of exit sign into Part B and it will snap into place.
